And when the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they brought Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every male who first opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord") and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the Law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons." (Luke 2:22-24)

When Jesus was forty days old, His family went to Jerusalem, several miles from Bethlehem, to do what God's law commanded. Jesus Himself would have been presented before the Lord, and an offering made for Him as a firstborn Son. Mary had to make an offering too, which normally would have been a lamb—but it looks like the family couldn't afford it, so they offered a pair of birds instead (see Leviticus 12:8).

How strange it seems, that the family of God's own Son couldn't afford the usual offering in God's temple! But in another way, it sounds right—for Mary and Joseph did bring a lamb, after all. They brought Jesus Himself, the Lamb of God, who would offer Himself as a sacrifice on behalf of the entire human family one day. Through His death He would redeem all of us; and through His resurrection He would become the Source of life for all of us who trust in Him.

WE PRAY: Lord, thank You for making Yourself an offering for me, so I could be Yours forever. Amen.

Council Meeting Minutes - Tuesday, November 19th, 2024

These minutes are abbreviated. If you would like the full minutes, ask a council member.

The meeting was called to order by President, Dwight E. and prayer by Pastor Kevin for our meal.

The following members were in attendance: Dwight Ebel, Kelly Klem, Gary Hansen, Matt Haugen, Wendy Johnson, Kayla Fenster and Pastor Kevin Beard. Accepted previous meetings minutes.

<u>Pastor's report:</u> Pastor Beard is doing first communion classes with four students in attendance. Confirmation is going 100% better than last year and this is due to the new system of putting classes and paperwork online for those who may not be able to attend. Things are going well.

<u>Treasurers report:</u> Kelly advises that we on budget and ahead of where we expected to be. 2 CD's are due Dec 11th with \$9,000 earning on them. There is \$81,000 in checking and \$83,000 in savings and can fund the upcoming altar construction project. Kelly will be checking interest rates on CD's. M/S/A

Old business:

Bathroom Signage: Pastor Beard will follow up on this.

<u>Sewer issues:</u> Signs were switched for the downstairs bathrooms. This seems to have fixed any issues.

<u>Fellowship windows:</u> Nothing new about the windows at this time.

<u>Parking lot:</u> Gary will be getting quotes to fix the East corner of the building on the West end of the parking lot.

New Business:

<u>Altar remodel:</u> Rick Tofte updated on the altar remodel. There will be stained glass with backlighting. People from the congregation will assist in making the glass. Sidney Millwork will do the woodwork. This new wall would be built out 5 feet to add additional

storage. This project could be done sometime this winter and take approximately 3 weeks minimum. Final numbers/cost will be obtained.

<u>Pastor retirement program:</u> The existing LOC 403B retirement program for Pastor. This plan costs the church appx \$1,000 a year. The AALC has a 403B retirement plan at no cost to the church and provides similar investment choices to Pastor. Council approved moving the retirement plan to the AALC plan.

<u>Daycare lease:</u> The council approved a new three-year lease at \$3,000 per month.

Budget discussion: Proposed

The budget for 2025 will be very similar to 2024's budget. \$1500 from the Lenten offering will be split between food banks in town, Gloria Dei food pantry and the Methodist church.

<u>Pastor pay:</u> Pastor Beard does not take insurance pay due to being on wife's insurance, so \$9,000 will be put into housing costs, up from \$6,000. An increase raise in pay of 5.62% from \$30,000 to \$31,800 is proposed.

Shelli Patch: It is proposed to increase pay \$120 for Shelly due to work that she does to assist the pastor with donations tracking on Church 360, helping with bulletins between two churches among numerous other things.

<u>Door Stoppers:</u> Replacing the door stoppers on the sanctuary doors. Matt will contact Tri County.

Annual Meeting: Kelly made a motion that the annual meeting be scheduled for January 26th, 2025.

<u>Facility use form discussion:</u> The council discussed possibly adding a line to our facility use form: "subject to pastoral review" about other pastors/services being held at our church. Kelly moved to have this line added, Wendy seconded. Motion passed. Pastor Beard will email the new form out when completed.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Wendy and seconded by Gary. Motion passed.


